

California Larrikins 20th Anniversary

2010 Camp Out FAQ *(read it, learn it, live it)...*



Q: How do I get to the campout?

The campout is at the Vail Lake Resort in Temecula. To get there take I-15 North to the Temecula Pkwy/CA-79S Exit and take a right (East). Follow CA-79S for 8.8 miles to Vail Lake Road and turn left. There is a huge Vail Lake sign there.

When you arrive at Vail Lake pull up to the guard shack and tell them you are with the Larrikin Campout and your name (real). They will have our access list and should let you in and might even give you directions to our area. If not, just follow the signs and flour to the area we have reserved, which is at the end of Lower Arroyo Seco (vicinity of campsites 512-520). Get there; get a beer, set up your shit.... Late comers, just pretend you're going to the office.

Q: What time should I get to the campout?

We know that many of you have jobs, but we recommend that you get there as early as possible, ideally between 4:00 and 6:00 pm on Friday. There will be a hash run at 6:30, and it's good to setup your tent before the hash. Otherwise, it might be dark, and you might be drunk.

Q: Can I just show up at the campout without registering in advance?

Sure. You'll probably need to bluff your way through the guard shack since you won't be on the registration list. Registration also costs more day-off. So, if you decide you want to join us, even if it's just a couple of days before, try to register online. It saves you money and allows us to get the right amount of food...and more importantly, beer.

Q: What do I have to bring?

These things are mandatory:

- A mug or other drinking vessel. We will have 10 cups for Tip Cup, and one 1 cup for all non-mug-bringing motherfuckers to share.
- sun screen.
- tent, sleeping bag
- flashlight, headlamp
- running clothes for three hashes (okay not mandatory, but don't be a wanker and miss the awesome trails)
- warm clothes for nighttime
- a good attitude - no assholes will be tolerated!

Q: What else should I bring?

These things are recommended:

- camp chair
- Camelback or something to carry water in on the run. We will provide one plastic water bottle for each run. This is really a good idea.
- swim suit (only if you are a chick, or Lacey)
- bug spray
- Tecnu (for poison oak, it has been sighted in this area)
- Astroglide, condoms, butt plugs
- Spare toilet paper (you're camping, remember?)

Q: What should I not bring?

These things should be left at home:

- Kids/Children/Minors. Seriously, we'll call CPS on you.
- anything you won't take home with you.
- beer, wine, or alcohol unless you are picky. Actually do bring, just realize that we are providing shit loads.
- fireworks... don't.
- firearms, really, don't.

Q: What will the weather be like?

Due to unusual weather, the current 10 day forecast as of August 1 is 85/day, 60/night.

Otherwise, it will be fucking hot during the day and pleasantly cool at night. On this weekend last year, the high afternoon temperature was 100, and the nighttime low was 55 (normal for this time of the year). Dehydration is a concern on the run. To quote trail master Snoop Pussy Pussy, who was at the campsite scouting trail during the recent heat wave: "it's hot as balls." We will provide bottled water for the trail, but your own Camelback or alternative is recommended. However, it will not be a complete flaming hellscape. The campsite has plenty of shade trees and mismanagement has some water features planned to keep you cool - plus, of course, plenty of ice cold beer.

Q: What is the campground like?

We have a block of 21 campsites reserved at the far end of the Lower Arroyo Seco area. Each of these campsites has a water spigot, an electrical outlet, and parking presumably large enough to park an RV. Speaking of RV's and trailers, if you plan on bringing one, and have not already arranged an assigned space, contact CLH3 Mismanagement (contact info at the bottom)

IMPORANT: The water flowing from the campsite spigots is non-potable - Translation: Unless you want to end up on that TV show Monsters Inside Me, **DON'T DRINK THE WATER!** Of course, there will be plenty of drinking water available at hash central. Bring your own water vessel.

Where you camp is up to you and is first come/first serve - another good reason to get there early. You don't want to end up in LoserTown. You also don't want to camp near the Reefer Truck (the big white truck with the diesel refrigeration unit that will keep you awake when you finally decide to pass out at 4am).

Spend a few minutes looking for a campsite. Usually everyone shows up and they drop their shit where they see everyone else, and we end up with a half empty campsite. Let's spread out, okay?

Q: What is the bathroom/shower situation?

The campground has permanent facilities for your excretory needs. Apparently they are nearby. These are shared with non-hash campers, so, ya' know, keep it in the bowl.

Q: What about water and showers?

As mentioned before each of the campsites has a water spigot with non-potable water - good for rinsing, not for drinking. There are also showers a short walk away! No pooping in the showers!

Q: Is there electricity available?

Yes! Multiple outlets are spread throughout the campsite.

Q: What is the parking situation?

Parking should not be a problem since each of the campsites can accommodate an RV and then some. There will need to be some tripling, quadrupling, and quintupling up to make this work. Consider backing in. Campout master ZAP (and battlefield re-creator) has a grand plan for an inverse pie wedge of tents, then RV's, then cars, then fencing that should provide the hash with a bulwark against civilian intrusion. If you see a crazy man with a flashlight telling you to park somewhere... please do as he says. Also, Village Tool, please park your car on CA-79.

Q: What will we be doing besides drinking?

See the schedule for full details, but we do have at least three hashes (some with Turkey/Eagle splits), lots of things spewing water, water to sit in, water to soak in, and water to slide down, 20th anniversary roast of the Larrikins Founders, The Return of BOOBS!, fucking awesome hash Olympics (now less complicated, more drunk!), Hash Elections, Sloppy Fun Run and Shot Contest Spaztacular

Q: What's this I've been hearing about a Sloppy Fun Run and Shot Contest?

The Sloppy Fun Run will be on Saturday night. It will be a tent to tent "bar" crawl type event. Your hare will lead you around the campsite from tent to tent where your fellow Larrikins will have made their favorite shot for you to try. They will be competing for the Shot Contest trophy so please try to remember how they taste as you go along. If you are interested in submitting a shot for the competition, contact BOOBS - boobsH3 @ gmail.com. Just be aware that you will need to provide a shot for everyone on the run, and you've basically got to pay for it. Hey, glory ain't free!

Q: How will we soak up all of the alcohol we will be drinking?

We are supplying hot meals from Friday dinner through Saturday dinner. Sunday will consist of breakfast and lunch, which will be cold meals, but will be good. We have attempted to plan for a few (non-vegan) vegetarians, and every meal has a white meat option. There will be snacks available in between meals.

Q: What will be available to drink?

We have many kegs of beer (both dark and light), wine, champagne, OJ for mimosas, bloody Mary mix, and basic liquors (for example, Vodka, Rum, Jim Beam, Tequila) and many soda and juice mixers.

There will be plenty of water, Gatorade and some non-alcoholic drinks (some sodas) as well; and of course ice. Bring your own water container (Nalgene, sports bottle, etc.) as we are only providing individual water bottles for the Saturday run.

However, if you have something specific you want to drink bring it for sure, but know we are providing a lot of fluids.

Q: Is this really a sausage fest?

Hardly. I've heard just the opposite, unless you're looking for a sausage fest. In which case, yeah...sausage fest.

Q: Are there any other rules that I should be aware of?

Yes, for everyone's fun and safety, please follow these few **RULES**:

- Quiet Hours – Hate to admit that such a thing exists, but...Vail Lake Resort has posted Quiet Hours starting at 10pm. What does this mean? We won't know until we are there and test the limits. We do not want to test that limit on Friday night. Hash Central is where the beer will be and that's where you should be. If you can help it, try not to throw a personal mini-rave at your campsite.
- From Snoop Pussy Pussy, no exposed genitals in the food lines. (This means you Rub!) People are trying to eat, and God forbid you get your sweaty balls in our guacamole dip.
- Dogs are allowed at Vail Lake and at the campout...but you must keep your dog on a leash and pick up after them. In our experience, most dogs don't enjoy hash campouts. Your choice.
- Gerbils are allowed at Vail Lake and at the campout.
- No fires or fireworks. There will be a fire at hash central. Don't build your own.
- No throwing gasoline or other accelerants on the bonfire. Seriously, Gorilla Whorefare, you fucking idiot.
- To re-iterate, while many of you will be building your campout sex palaces to make for the ultimate fucktastic weekend, don't leave your crap.
